Using the specifications for May 2009 block - Attic Windows, members should replace the animals with a beach scene. There are numerous beaches in Stanley Park, 2nd and 3rd beach come to mind. The lucky winner of these attic windows blocks should have a wonderful cheery quilt to look at on some of our drearier West Coast days!

**Fabric Colours:** Light brown, light yellow and a beach scene

Cut 1 – 6.5 “ square of anything that reminds you of a beach scene.

Cut 1 - 3.5 X 11 “ Rectangle of light brown

Cut 1 - 3.5 X 11 “ Rectangle of light yellow

Place the lt. brown rectangle on the left side of the chosen print and sew partial seam down to 1/4” from the end, backstitch.

Take your yellow and sew it to the bottom of your chosen print stopping 1/4” from the end.

Fold your block in half diagonally and make sure that your rectangles meet evenly.

Lay a ruler along your diagonal line and mark as close as you can to the ruler with a pencil.

That will be your sewing line.

Cut 1/4 “ away from the sewn line.

Or choose your favourite method for making Attic Windows.

Block should measure 9 1/2” unfinished.
