Any member who has a daughter, granddaughter or niece has probably been through the "pink and purple stage". In addition the fascination with hearts and butterflies is quite common, so for all my lovely nieces here is a Hearts and Butterflies block for February in a traditional nine patch block.

Directions:

3 - 3 1/2" square deep pink squares

4 - 3 1/2" square white squares

1 - 4" square purple

1 - 4" square white

Place white and purple 4" squares together, right sides facing

Draw a pencil line diagonally on the back of the white square

Sew 1/4" on either side of the line

Cut on the pencil line

Trim the half square triangles to 3 1/2" squares

Assemble in rows

Top: white, half square, white

Middle: Pink, white, half square

Bottom: Pink, pink, white

To use as a signature block you could place the signature to form the embroidered body of the butterfly.
