

**Fraser Valley Quilters' Guild
May 2015 Block of the Month**



Cut 6 - 3 1/2" squares of white-on-white background fabric
Cut 3 - 3 1/2" squares of your choice of umbrella fabric
Cut 3 - 4" squares of umbrella fabric
Cut 1 - 1" by 8" stripe of dark fabric

Fold the three 4 inch squares into triangles.
Place each triangle on a white 3 1/2" square and baste in place.

Trim to 3 1/2"

Assemble the block finger pressing the folded triangles to create a curved edge.
Fold the strip in 1/4" on either side and stitch in place.

Or use a method of your choice.

Stitch close to the curved edges of the umbrella.
