Think of pinkish red maple leaves floating along in the blue water of creeks and lakes when choosing your fabrics.



- Cut two 3 1/2" water blue squares. Cut one in half and sew in 1" strip of leaf fabric and trim square.
- Cut two 3 1/2" pinkish-red leaf squares.
- Cut two 4" squares of background and leaf fabrics. Cut into half square triangles and sew together in pairs.
- Trim to 3 1/2" squares.
- Cut one 3 21/2" muslin square. Fold in half point to point and then into quarters. Sew pinkish-red leaf fabric along quarter lines leaving muslin strip in centre. Trim to 3 1/2" square.
- Lay out blocks per pattern and sew as nine patch.
