

## CHAIN BLOCK - 10 INCH UNFINISHED

Fabric requirements

White background – four – 3 ½ inch squares cut once on the diagonal

four - 1 ½ by 3 ½ inch rectangles

Four different colours – your choice but keep them bright and cheerful

From each one cut – one 3 ½ inch square cut once on the diagonal

Two – 1 ½ inch by 3 ½ inch rectangles

Use a scant ¼ inch seam allowance throughout.

From the first colour, sew a rectangular strip on each side of a white strip. Press the seams toward the coloured fabric.

Using the same colour, sew the coloured triangles on so the seam crosses the three rectangles.

**\*\*\*important\*\*\* Be sure to centre all your triangles when attaching them to have success putting this block together. You can find the centre by pressing a little crease in the triangle and also in the block, then match the creases. Be sure to attach the coloured triangles first.**

Now attach the white triangles to the other two corners. They will be against the coloured rectangles.

Repeat this with your other three colours.

Put the four blocks together as you would a four patch.

C – colour

W – white
