

April Block of the Month: King's Crown Spring green and gold



Cut squares:

For the geese: one $5\frac{3}{4}$ " yellow, four $3\frac{1}{8}$ " green

Centre: one 5" green

Corners: four $2\frac{3}{4}$ " white



Make four flying geese:

I'm using this way of making flying geese www.patchpieces.com/files/flyinggeese.pdf but you can make them any way you want. They finish at $4\frac{1}{2}$ " by $2\frac{1}{4}$ " (that is 5" by $2\frac{3}{4}$ " with seam allowances included).

Draw a line diagonally across the small green squares. Place them on opposite corners of the yellow

square and stitch $\frac{1}{4}$ " on each side of the line. Then cut on the drawn line.



Press the seams open. Lay the small green squares on the yellow corners. Stitch $\frac{1}{4}$ " on each side of the drawn line.



Cut along the drawn line and press open to reveal your geese. Trim them to 5" by $2\frac{3}{4}$ ".

Layout: Arrange the geese and the other squares like this and stitch the rows together, then join the rows.
