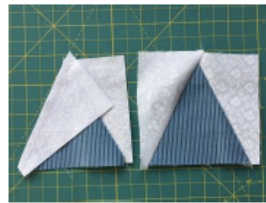
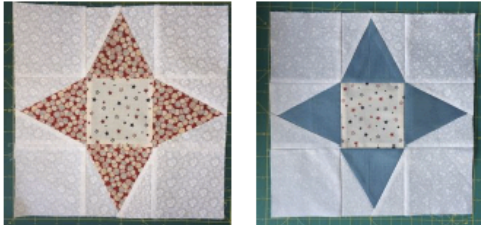


**March Block of the Month**

**Block of the Month-March**

Finishes at 9½"



Lay the reversed side triangle piece on the coloured triangle. Stich and press toward the white.

Cutting:

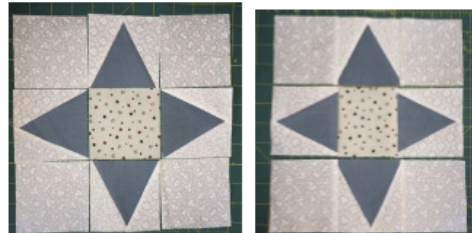


- four white 3½ inch squares
- one light print 3½ inch square
- four blue or white triangles
- four side triangles
- four side triangles, reversed

Trim to 3 ½ inches. Leave at least ¼ inch above the point and centre the triangles.



Lay out the triangle blocks and the squares:



Stitch in three rows, pressing toward the white; then join the rows.

Use templates picked up at the meeting or cut the triangles and side triangles as follows.

For the triangles: cut four squares 3¾" from the blue or red fabric. Stack them. On each side, cut diagonally from the centre top to each bottom outside corner.

For the side triangles: cut four rectangles 2½" x 5" from white fabric. Stack them. Cut diagonally to get four side triangles and four reversed.

Assemble the triangle blocks:



Lay a white side triangle piece onto the coloured triangle. Stich one side, press toward the dark.
